Part 1: Choose an Emerging Trend to research and prepare a report:

- Explain the trend (what it is, current status, trend, industry products, etc)
- Analyze and project how this will change the way we do business.
- The paper is not to exceed 6 total pages as follows:
 - Title page
 - Abstract page
 - Report (maximum of 3 double spaced pages)
 - References page

Sources should be books, journal articles and/or conference papers. <u>Web</u> <u>sites that are not journal articles or conference papers must be approved by the instructor or they</u> <u>may not be used. NO blogs, opinion pieces, "pedia" sites, Huffington Post, CNN, FoxNews, etc.</u>

Part 2: Create presentation materials

Create presentation materials using Microsoft PowerPoint that could be used if you were presenting your project findings. This is meant to be a visual aid as if you are presenting, not a duplication of your paper. Citations are not required on the slides. Consider using keywords and phrases from the paper that would help you stay on topic if you were presenting the paper to a group.
